

Discipline 2 - Petzen Climbing Trophy:

Lead-climbing competition

○ **Principles**

- Common competition rules are used
- Top-rope-belaying: heat C
- Lead-climb-belaying: heats B, A, Y
- Starting order is identical with starting numbers in heat
- Simultaneous climbing during qualifying rounds and finals; only one climber a time during super final
- In case of coloured routes it is only allowed to use holds and footholds of that specific colour
- Route length: about 10 to 16 m
- Appealing time is 15 min after results have been published
- Organizational details are communicated during the meeting of team managers

○ **Scoring**

- Number of holds (+/-) determines obligatory height-score
- In case of top-rope 'top' is awarded only if the top-hold is being held with both hands
- In case of lead-climb 'top' is awarded only if the last quickdraw is attached

○ **Qualifying rounds** - 2 routes / flash / lead-climb

- Starting order is identical with starting list
- Climbing time is communicated during the meeting of team managers
- Number of holds (+/-) determines obligatory height-score
- Qualifying round results are decisive for reaching the final
- Top 6 climbers of every heat qualify for the final
- In case of smaller heats only 5 climbers advance to the final

○ **Final** – 1 route / on sight / quota: 6 + equal scores

- Starting order is identical with starting list
- Isolation zone time has to be followed
- Number of holds (+/-) determines obligatory height-score
- In case of equal scores there is an additional super final

○ **Super-final** – 1 route / on sight / only top-seeded

- Drawing makes starting order
- Number of holds (+/-) determines obligatory height-score

○ **Presentation ceremony** – attendance obligatory

- Individual results for the top 3 of every single heat
- Awarding of cup-points for group results
