

Discipline 3 - Petzen Climbing Trophy:

Boulder competition

○ **Principles**

- Common competition rules are used
- Crash pads are used for safety
- 4 to 10 moves per problem/boulder
- In case of coloured boulders it is only allowed to use the holds and footholds of that specific colour
- Appealing is only possible IMMEDIATELY after scoring round
- Every scoring round lasts about 90 min (at least 30 min)
- Organizational details are communicated during the meeting of team managers

○ **Scoring**

- 'Top' is awarded only if the top-hold is being HELD with BOTH HANDS
- 'Zone' is awarded only if the zone-hold is being HELD
- In both cases judges' confirmation is obligatory
- Score is made up after top and tries and after zone and tries
- Score consists of divided problem points plus bonus points
- Problem points are awarded proportionately to the successful contestants
- Bonus points for top & zone: 1st try +3, 2nd try +2, 3rd try +1
- Classification is made up by adding problem points and bonus points

○ **Qualifying round** – 10 to 12 problems / flash without lead-climb:

- Total climbing time per heat is about 90 min (at least 30 min)
- Neither starting order nor problem order is prescribed
- Only the judge can allow start
- After every single try starters have to be switched
- No maximizing tries at problems
- No final

○ **Super-final** - 1 problem / on sight:

- Drawing makes starting order
- Number of holds (+/-) determines height-score

○ **Presentation ceremony** – attendance obligatory

- Individual results for the top 3 of every single heat
- Awarding of cup-points for group results
